## LIVE! ROUNDUP PINK POWERS ON: THE 'TRAUMA' TREK TOWERS STATESIDE

**P**INK LANDS IN Hot Tickets with two performances reported from the first 2019 leg of her Beautiful Trauma world tour, which launched March 1. Among the shows eligible for this month's charts, sold-out concerts at Detroit's Little Caesars Arena scored the highest gross, landing on the More Than 15,000 Capacity group at No. 4 with \$4.5 million in sales. The ticket count hit 30,499 for the two-show run April 26-27. The first performance was one of two postponed when she contracted the flu in spring 2018 not long after the tour launched. A March 2018 date in Montreal was also rescheduled for this year.

Four more concerts also fall during the eligibility time period for the June charts, all with grosses topping \$2 million from sellout crowds. Pink performed for 14,055 fans April 17 at SAP Center in San Jose, Calif., with a \$2.1 million take, then ended the month with sales of 14,444 tickets surpassing \$2 million at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. On May 2 she racked up \$2.3 million in sales from 13,331 tickets at Fiserv Forum in Milwaukee, and she played for a crowd of 15,050 the following week on May 7 at CHI Health Center in Omaha, Neb.

The Beautiful Trauma tour's kickoff in 2018 — also on March 1 — was a sold-out Phoenix event that ushered in a string of U.S. and Canadian dates through the beginning of June, followed by an Oceania trek from July through September of last year. After she took more than five months off the road, her current 39-show North American jaunt is set to wrap with a two-night stint in New York City on May 21-22.

So far, the tour is averaging 14,332 sold tickets per show, based on 105 concerts that have been reported from arenas in both North America and Oceania since launch. The average gross from all reported shows registers at \$1.93 million. In 2018 only one stadium (Forsyth Barr Stadium in Dunedin, New Zealand) was included along with the arenas booked on the tour, but the coming European trek this summer will be staged almost exclusively in stadiums. Pink will also make a headlining festival appearance at Rock Werchter in Belgium on June 27.

Meanwhile, Post Malone hits Hot Tickets with four charted events from the Australian trek supporting "Beerbongs & Bentleys," his sophomore studio album released last year.

He places four events on the 10,001-15,000 chart with top grosses coming from Melbourne's Rod Laver Arena. The hip-hop star raked in more than \$3.9 million from 39,530 tickets at three performances to grab the No. 2 ranking. He also takes the fifth, sixth and eighth positions on the chart with sellouts in Brisbane, Perth and Adelaide, respectively.

The Brisbane Entertainment Centre moved 24,081 tickets for his shows May 4-5 with sales topping \$2.2 million, and his performance April 26 at Perth's RAC Arena follows with \$1.5 million in earnings from 14,599 sold seats. Finally, at No. 8, he logged \$900,497 at the box office for an April 28 show at Adelaide Entertainment Centre with attendance registered at 9,244. — Bob Allen
