

MIDYEAR REPORT: EXTENDED

Multiday runs from stars and festivals dominate charts for early 2019 — here are some highlights

BTS CHARTS ON Hot Tickets with three stadiums, all with concert grosses topping the \$10 million mark from two-show engagements. The top box-office counts were logged at the Rose Bowl, where the South Korean boy band drew 113,040 fans over both nights. Sales revenue at the Pasadena, Calif., stadium hit \$16.5 million from sellouts on May 4 and 5.

- Heading up the 15,001-30,000 category is the Bud Light Music Festival, a three-night event at Atlanta's State Farm Arena leading up to Super Bowl LIII, which was played Feb. 3 at nearby Mercedes-Benz Stadium. The music fest featured appearances by Cardi B, Aerosmith, Ludacris and others and produced a combined gross of \$11.3 million.

- Park Theater at Park MGM lands on Hot Tickets with multiple-date appearances by Lady Gaga and Aerosmith, both with residencies this year at the Las Vegas entertainment venue. The pop diva takes four positions on the 5,001-10,000 chart based on performances of her two productions, "Enigma" and "Jazz & Piano." Aerosmith lands at Nos. 6, 7 and 8 with three-night stints of the band's "Deuces Are Wild" residency.

- The popularity of the Broadway sensation "Hamilton" is as evident on Hot Tickets as it is on any given night for fans entering the Richard Rodgers Theatre in New York City. The national tour of the Tony Award-winning musical hits the 2,001-5,000 chart nine times with grosses reported from eight-show

runs at five theaters. The top box-office take was \$4.1 million at the Bushnell Center's Mortensen Hall in Hartford, Conn., earned from eight performances during the week before Christmas.

- Latin promoter OCESA/CIE scores Hot Tickets entries for three festivals during the first half of 2019 led by Electric Daisy Carnival at Foro Sol in Mexico City on Feb. 23-24. The two-day electronic dance music event earned \$10.4 million to take the No. 7 ranking in the largest-capacity category. The promoter's Vive Latino two-day event at the same stadium

in March follows in ninth place on the chart, while Pa'L Norte is No. 10. Also running for two days in March, that festival was held in Monterrey, Mexico, at Parque Fundidora.

- The No. 1 arena worldwide in the 15,001-30,000 group comes from Germany as Cologne's Lanxess Arena takes the top ranking with 699,924 sold tickets at 84 performances during the midyear eligibility period. Almost a third of those tickets were for the Lachende Kölnarena event with 15 performances during February and March. Local band Bläck Fööss led a lineup of more than 40 entertainers on

stage at the venue during the four-week run. This year's top ranking marks a jump of three positions for Lanxess Arena after taking the No. 4 slot on last year's midyear Top Stops chart.

- International presence is vibrant on the

Top Stops category for venues with capacities of 10,001-15,000 seats. Six countries are represented among the 15 venues that land on the chart. Midsize arenas outside of North America account for 11 positions, including the No. 1 venue, the SSE Hydro in Glasgow, Scotland, with a sold ticket tally of 564,777.

- Perennial chart-topper Auditorio Nacional in Mexico City returns to No. 1 on Top Stops with a total ticket count of 613,817 from 86 performances during the midyear time frame. That is down slightly from the theater's top-ranked 99-show ticket total of 852,077 in 2018. ▣

NYCB Live's Nassau Veterans Memorial Coliseum on New York's Long Island fares the best among American venues, taking the fifth ranking with 244,015 total tickets.

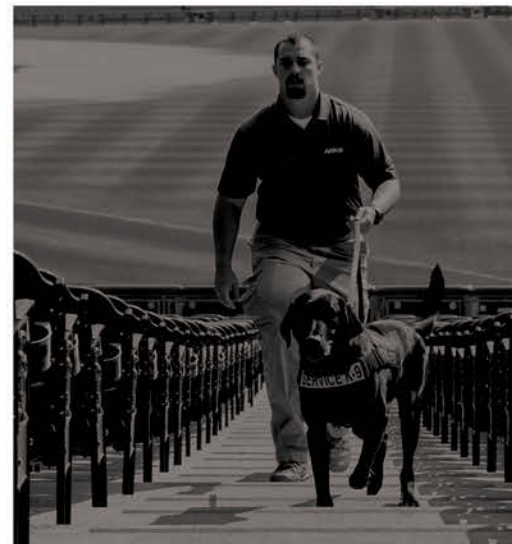
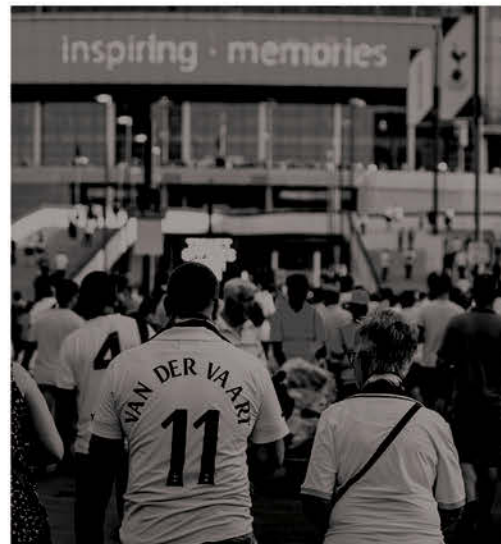
